The next 15 months, George served as a cook in non-combat Seoul, Korea on occupation duty. He shipped souvenirs back home and eventually shipped himself back to Southern California to rejoin the family farm and then the Parks Department in Anaheim, until he retired in 1985. He met his wife, Beverly, and raised 2 sons and 2 daughters. Survived today by only one daughter, Jan, George moved to Texas to be near her in 2002.

He's been working on putting his memories on paper for future generations. His fascinating descriptions and oral history have been recorded and honored by Gary Sinise's Soaring Valor Foundation, where he and his daughter traveled to New Orleans for the ceremony. While George is certainly a decorated WWII veteran, he is also nothing short of a National treasure. The boldness and courage of men and women like George is why we appreciate the lives we have today. I'm proud to know George and I'm proud to live in the country he protected.
